Dear Praying Friends and Supporters,

Greetings in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We trust in the Lord that this finds you all in good health and spirit. We highly appreciate you for lifting us in your prayer to continue the mission of God. It is our honor and privilege to serve in a multi-cultural society to reach out to a diverse people group. Let us have this opportunity to share a brief update to you:

## Bible Study

We run our weekly Bible study every Wednesday from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm. We are currently studying the book of Hebrews. We are thankful to the Lord that recently the number of attendees has grown from 6 to 13 people. Four new members have joined the Bible study. Although they are not believers yet, they have many questions about the Bible and Christianity. This has given us a wonderful opportunity to share the Good News with them. Two of them have also attended the church service. I hope and pray that they will accept the Lord Jesus as their Saviour.



## Baptism

We are thankful to the Lord for bringing four Iranians to our church who are living in the UK as refugees. They have been very eager to attend church. As a church, we provided them with welcome packs containing household items worth £20 each. One of them joined the Alpha Course and was baptised at Nelson Street Church.

I have just completed three sessions of baptism classes for four members of our church. Among them, two are from Urdu-speaking backgrounds, one is a Hindu from Mauritius, and another is from Malta. We are planning to hold a baptism ceremony in July. Please pray for the planning and preparation so that it will be a joyful and victorious occasion.



## Outreach on the Street of Roachdale.

It gives us tremendous joy to go out on the streets every Wednesday and Friday to evangelise. I have met many people and had opportunities to share the Good News with

them and distribute Bibles and tracts. Within the last two months, four people have accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour and Lord. My colleagues, Ray and Doug, and I have prayed for several people and led them to Christ.

At the same time, we also experience hatred and opposition from some people. The comments they make can be very disrespectful and appalling, and some even use offensive language when we try to distribute literature. I have also noticed that some Muslims accept the literature but later throw it in the bin.

### Testimony:

One of our members, Alia, who comes from a Pakistani background, has been attending church regularly for almost five months. The Lord is working in her life, and she is becoming stronger and more passionate about Scripture and fellowship.

She is married to an English man who is not happy about her decision to follow Jesus and has been harsh toward her. However, she says:

“I am thankful to the Lord that He has chosen me. I am ready to face any challenge and stand firm for Jesus.”



She has remained steadfast not only at church but also at home. She reads the Bible aloud so that her husband and daughter can hear what she is reading. We are very thankful to the Lord for her faith in Him, and she is now one of the members preparing for baptism.

### Community Engagement

As part of community transformation and engagement, I volunteer every Tuesday to support a charity called Caring and Caring. I spend time with people aged 50 and above, helping them engage in drawing and craft activities so that they can refresh their minds and feel valued within the community.

Most of them are migrants who struggle to integrate into society and often feel lonely. Programmes like this help boost their morale and refresh their minds by involving them in meaningful activities rather than remaining isolated at home.
